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## **Four Seasons Hotel Seattle Opens Oct. 27**



The Four Seasons Seattle is back. After closing its doors in 2003, the venerable name will reopen in a new \$150 million, 21-story hotel and condominium tower in the city's downtown, adjacent to Pike Place Market and Seattle Art Museum. With 147 rooms, a new restaurant and bar helmed by chef Kerry Sear, a full-service spa and a curated art collection focusing on masters of the Northwest School, guests of the hotel--which offers stunning views of Elliott Bay and the Olympic Mountains--won't be disappointed.

Owners of the 36 private residences--which start at \$2 million and range from 1,300 to 4,000 square feet--will have access to an on-call concierge service, valet parking and all the amenities offered to hotel guests.
